FARM SAFETY AND HAND WASHING NOTICE

Important notice from Leahy's to our customers.

Animals and the farm environment naturally carry germs, some of which may cause ill health, which in some cases can be severe or life threatening.

Hand washing is VERY IMPORTANT to remove any germs that may be on your hands or on the hands of those in your care.

Hands should be washed:

- After animal contact, including feeding animals
- After contact with animal feed or bedding
- After using the toilet
- Before eating or drinking
- On leaving the farm, even if you haven't had direct contact any animal
- After changing clothes or footwear worn on the farm visit

TO WASH HANDS WELL:

- Use running hot and cold or warm water and liquid soap
- build up a good lather
- dry thoroughly.
- Allow plenty of time for hand washing.

Remember, cleansing wipes or sanitizing gel are not acceptable substitutes for proper hand washing on a farm. Visitors have a personal responsibility to abide by the safety rules of this farm and to carry out hand washing.
